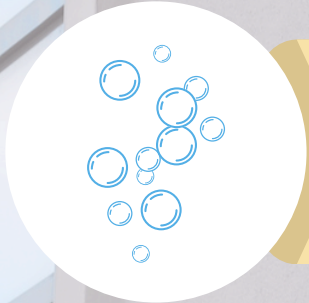
It's natural to be curious, but film is to be looked through, rather than at. Architectural standards judge a good install from 10ft back, an excellent one from 6ft (per International Window Film Association).

Exterior and interior window films are designed to last for decades. Here are some common questions and care procedures for your film!



No Window Cleaning For 7 -days!

Put your feet up and relax! The film needs some time in the sun to fully cure. This takes longer in cooler seasons. Windows with a northern exposure can also take more time to cure. Cleaning too soon can compromise the installation and/or adhesive.



What about the bubbles?

Water bubbles will disappear. On exterior applications (triple-pane or film installed on the outside) a few small particles or points may remain. They are generally only visible from the outside. They are typical of outdoor installs. They will not affect the heat reduction, glare reduction or other attributes of the film.



Is that a fog or haze?

Sometimes, as the slip agent and adhesive are curing, there can be a slight haze or milky appearance shortly after the installation. Don't worry, it will clear up in the sun! This can take 30-60 days in cooler weather, thicker film or a north-facing window.



Was it cut right?

There should be a clear border (roughly 1/16" to 1/8" (<3mm) around the perimeter of the film. This is the best practice to make sure the film bonds properly to the glass. This thin reveal allows slip-agent to cure properly and ensures that edges do not flip up or lose adhesion.



Are there special instructions for cleaning?

Tell any window cleaner that you have glazing film. Ensure they know not to use, pressurized water, brushes, metal blades or scrapers on the film. Use mild detergents, micro-fiber clothes, sponges or paper towel. A soft squeegee for a clear final pass!
